

Procurement of Goods and Services PT Bank Mandiri (Persero) Tbk.

 - Provisions for Change of Work (plus/minus) specifically in the field of construction implementation services.
 - Implementation of Procurement Activities to Overcome Certain Conditions.
 - Document and Payment Process.
- 3. Procurement Operational Technical Guidelines (PTO) that regulate, among others (Chapter III):
 - a. Implementation Provisions
 - Accreditation Partners (Goods and Services Providers)
 - General & including aspects that are reviewed in carrying out the qualifications of prospective Goods and Services Providers)
 - Procedures for partner accreditation (Goods and Services Providers) (including aspects considered in determining recommended partners to be invited in a procurement process)
 - Partner Monitoring includes:
 - i. Monitoring Partner Data
 - ii. Partner Performance Monitoring, which consists of:
 - 01. Evaluation of Partner Performance Periodically
 - 02. Evaluation of Partner Performance based on Contract
 - iii. Increasing Partner Competence
 - iv. Sanctions for Associates
